1. INTENT

2. CLARFICATION / ADDITION

Questions from Proposers due to Library answered by the St. Louis Public Library Director of Neighborhood Services

Does the library system already use an electronic survey software system? If so, would the consultant be able to have access to that system? Is it anticipated that the consultant would also analyze results?

No, the Library does not have electronic survey software system. However, Google forms offer options to collect data anonymously. In addition, we are open to exploring survey tools such as Survey Monkey. Yes, the consultant will also analyze the results. The results are a prime component that will drive the work. Administration and the DEI chair committee will want to see the results as well.

Is it possible to share the documentation/data that was used to create any strategic plans or other pertinent planning documentation?

The consultant will have access to the strategic plan, the DEI charge, and proposal.

We do not have one at this time. We would like to see tiered pricing.

What is the anticipated timeline for starting and completing this project? Ideally, we would like to begin the project in 2nd Qtr. 2021 if possible. Timeline and completion would depend on the consultant's recommendations and Administration's response to those recommendations.
