#### INTENT

This addendum is issued to provide an addition / modification in proposal plans and/or specifications.

#### 1. Add Annual Wage Order 29

Contractor and subcontractors (if any) shall, to the extent required by the Annual Wage Order 29 pay no less than the latest prevailing wage rates to workers and professionals as determined by the Division of Labor Standards, Wage and Hour Section.

- 2. The Contractor shall furnish the St. Louis Public Library, in a form satisfactory to the St. Louis Public Library, full and duly executed performance and payment bond, underwritten by a surety or sureties satisfactory to the St. Louis Public Library, in the full amount of this agreement. The Contractor's failure to deliver satisfactory bonds within ten (10) calendar days after demand may be deemed a material breach of the agreement.
- 3. Change the Bid Due Date, as follows:

March 24, 2023 by 2:00 pm.

Each objection shall certify that a copy has been furnished to the Division of Labor Standards, P.O. Box 449, Jefferson City, MO 65102-0449 pursuant to 8 CSR 20-5.010(1). A certified copy of the Annual Wage Order has been filed with the Secretary of State of Missouri.

Use Heavy Construction Rates on Highway and Heavy construction in accordance with the classifications of construction work established in 8 CSR 30-3.040(3).

Use Building Construction Rates on Building construction in accordance with the classifications of construction work established in 8 CSR 30-3.040(2).

If a worker is performing work on a heavy construction project within an occupational title that is not listed on the Heavy Construction Rate Sheet, use the rate for that occupational title as shown on the Building Construction Rate Sheet.

## OVERTIME and HOLIDAYS

#### **OVERTIME**

For all work performed on a Sunday or a holiday, not less than twice (2x) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work.

For all overtime work performed, not less than one and one-half (1½) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work or contractual obligation. For purposes of this subdivision, "overtime work" shall include work that exceeds ten hours in one day and work in excess of forty hours in one calendar week; and

A thirty-minute lunch period on each calendar day shall be allowed for each worker on a public works project, provided that such time shall not be considered as time worked.

#### HOLIDAYS

January first;
The last Monday in May;
July fourth;
The first Monday in September;
November eleventh;
The fourth Thursday in November; and December twenty-fifth;

If any holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday.

#### **Annual Wage Order Look-Up**

All public bodies of Missouri contemplating construction work must get an Annual Wage Order from Labor Standards. The Annual Wage Order lists the prevailing wage rates on public construction projects in each county. The rates must be incorporated into the contract specifications for any projects valued at more than \$75,000. This is the *minimum* wage rate required for the project. Employees are free to bargain for a higher rate of pay. Employers are free to pay a higher rate of pay.
